Airport Authority meets today

BULLHEAD CITY — Purchase of another hangar, land acquisition from the Arizona State Land Department, the \$9.3 million runway and taxiway extension project for Laughlin/Bullhead International Airport are on the agenda for today's Mohave County Airport Authority quarterly board meeting, at 9:30 a.m. in the Laughlin Ranch banquet room, 1360 William Hardy Drive, Bullhead City.

The MCAA operates the airport, which is self-supporting and does not receive funding from Mohave County, Clark County, Bullhead City or Laughlin.

At today's meeting, there will be an update on the terminal emergency power upgrade, which will begin in early April. When completed, a backup generator will be able to provide adequate lighting and air conditioning to the terminal in the event of a power outage.

The next regular board meeting is scheduled for 9 a.m. April 12.
